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
To Whom It May Concern:

Anderson Mason Dale Architects had the pleasure of working with Ward Construction on a \$4.6 million remodel/addition project at Broomfield High School for the Boulder Valley School District. Based on that experience, it is without reservation that I can recommend Ward Construction as a general contractor.

The Broomfield High School project involved very difficult remodel work, several small additions, and a large auditorium/theatre addition to an existing facility that had been previously modified numerous times. It seemed that at every location of new work, the conditions were different. In addition to the auditorium/theatre, work included new locker rooms, classrooms, laboratories, offices, lobby/circulation spaces, and site work. The project also had a very compressed construction schedule that had to be coordinated with normal academic usage of the facility.

We found Ward Construction, including Stan Ward, Paul Sommer and their very experienced field personnel, to be up to the challenge of this very complicated project. It was evident throughout that they shared the same desire as the Owner and architect to create a great facility. We do not always find this level of pride and dedication on the part of the contractor.
